

LEVEL 3 – SAFETY CHECKLIST FOR FAIR DAY PRESENTATION

Students and Parents must review the following Display Safety Checklist when completing the registration form. Non-compliant projects will be adjusted or eliminated from competition.

Project Display

- 1. Project apparatus is within the project display area.(4 ft wide x 2 ft deep)
- 2. The exhibit items and backboard are self-standing and stable, or secured to table.
- 3. All sharp edges on project or display are removed or protected.
- 4. Electrical cords, hoses, etc. do not create a tripping hazard and access to an electrical cord must be requested at time of registration and cannot be guaranteed. Bring battery back-up for laptop plug in.
- 5. No more than 2 people are presenting this project.

Human Projects

- 6. Display may include pictures of participants if prior permission has been obtained.
- 7. Appropriate Ethics and Permission Forms are contained in logbook (Gr 7 – 12)

Animal Projects

- 8. Live animals are not being displayed (provide photographs)
- 9. Appropriate Ethics Forms confirming that the animals underwent no distress (Gr 7-12)

Chemicals

- 10. Any flammable or poisonous chemicals (solid, liquid, gas) (including household cleaning products) are not to be brought to the Fair (use photographs)

Electrical

- 11. Electrical power bars, supplies and cords are in good condition, non-modified, CSA approved, and provide necessary grounding if required for apparatus.
- 12. No exposed live parts over 36 V. Exposed metal parts in systems over 36V are grounded.
- 13. Only sealed type batteries are used.

Fire Safety

- 14. No flames are used in display
- 15. Packing material has been removed from the Exhibit Hall.

Microorganism & Biohazards

- 16. No plants, plant tissues or soils shall be exhibited. (please use photographs)
- 17. No bacteria, fungi or amoeba will be displayed in petri dishes (please use photographs)

Pressure Systems & Explosives

- 20. Air/ Hydraulic pressure systems are non-operational and open to atmosphere
- 21. No Pressurized tanks, canisters or gas cylinders are in the display
